




Figure 1 is a top perspective view of a boat showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the boat;

Figure 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and Figures 4 and 5 are rear and front elevational views,

respectively, thereof.

The side of the boat not shown is the same as that shown. The break in the back of the front seat extends to the floor, and the backs of the seats are plain.
